

## Report



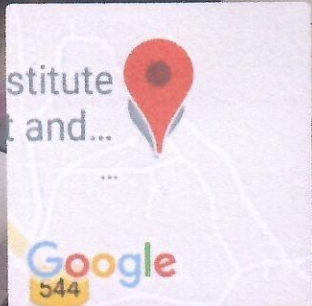
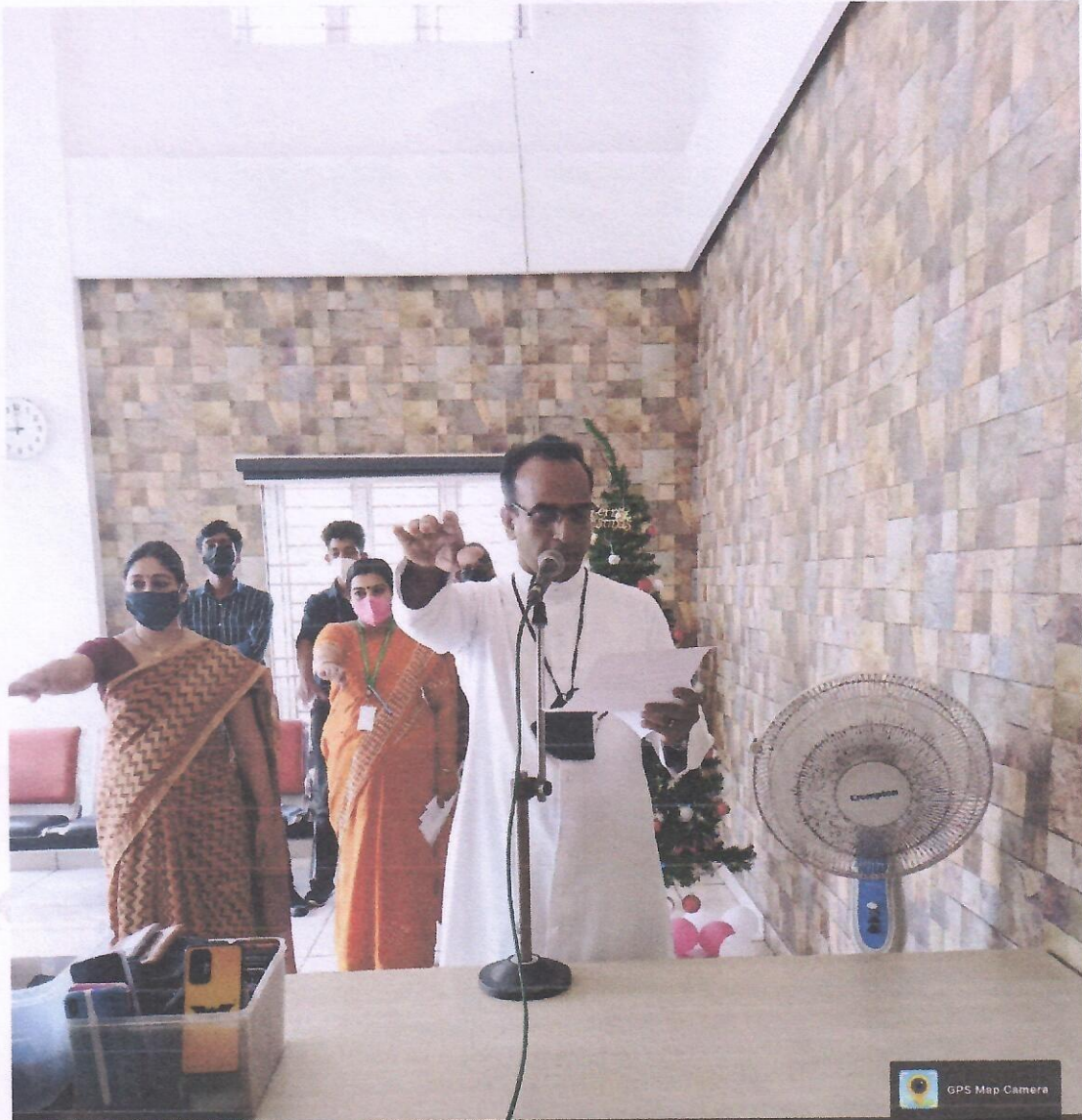
