

Research Quality Assurance Cell (RQAC)

Annual Report – 2021-22

The research activities for the academic year 2021-22 started with R Collective Ver.3.0. As per the research committee meeting decision on 17-11-2022, the faculty members of every department were divided into groups under a leader to support the members to come out with publications in UGC and SCOPUS indexed journals. Also decided to start Student Research Programme (SRP), to support the WWS students for publishing their own research papers. As an outcome, overall we got 30+6 UGC publications (2 Scopus), 15 ISSN publications, 30 ISBN edited volume publications and 2 book publications with ISBN number.

All departments conducted National Conferences and the corresponding ISBN Conference Proceedings are ready with ISBN numbers. The printing part is over and the hardcopy is available in the department of CS. The proceedings of other departments and College Research Journal NAIVIGYAN are sent out for printing and will be ready by this week.

To enhance the proficiency in ICT enabled learning practice, the faculty members are asked to prepare e-content/video presentation. And as of now we have a total of 55 e-contents developed (20 video presentations from Commerce, 10 from CS, 17 from Languages and 8 from HM).

The funded projects of all departments are under progress. The department of CS completed a data annotation work with Star Innovations and another one with the same organization is started now.

Faculty Exchange Programme (FEP) were organized in different departments. 4 FEP in Commerce (8 faculty members), 2 in Computer Science (2 faculty members) and 1 in Languages (2 faculty members).
